- **Fax/Scan:** Fax/Scan service is outgoing only. We are unable to receive documents due to limitations of our phone service. The fee for faxing is \$1 per page, excluding the cover page. The fee for scanning is \$1 flat rate with a max. of 20 pages per patron. Payment should be made at the time of the request.
- **Holds Pickup Locker:** The locker provides 24/7 access to your holds both during and/or after library hours. It provides convenient material pickup based on your schedule. Simply scan your library card, enter your PIN # and hit "Enter". The locker door swings open and your materials are automatically checked out to you.
- **Home Delivery Service (Collection Connection):** Open to all ages in the East Lake Fire district, this free service delivers library materials right to your door. To find out more or register for the service, see a staff member, call the library, fill out the online application at <https://www.eastlakelibrary.org/collection-connection> or email: elclcc@eastlakelibrary.org.
- **Interlibrary Loan (ILL):** ILL is a resource-sharing service that allows you to request books that are neither owned by ELCL, nor available within the Pinellas Public Library System. See a staff member or go to <https://www.eastlakelibrary.org/interlibrary-loans-ill>.
- **Notary:** We offer notary services for professionally composed legal documents. We have two notaries on staff for your convenience. We can certify a copy, affirm an oath and/or verify a signature. The notary services cost \$8.00 per document or "stamp." Please call ahead to make sure a staff notary is available to serve your needs.
- **Passports:** ELCL is a Passport Acceptance Facility! Services include executing new or expired passport applications (DS-11 form). Passport photos are also available for anyone. Please call the library or go to <https://www.eastlakelibrary.org/passports> for further information or to make an appointment!
- **Proctoring:** The Reference Librarian provides proctoring service at a cost of \$15 per exam. In addition, any costs incurred for receiving or returning tests (e.g., printing, postage, or faxing) will be paid by the student or the educational institution. Students must make an appointment with the Reference Librarian during regular business hours. No "drop-in" test proctoring is provided. See a staff member for details.
